Animal Subjects Research Training Guide:

All investigators and advisors involved in animal subject research are required to complete at minimum the "Working with the IACUC" training module. Additional elective training courses are available for a variety of common study species, as well as coursework for practices to minimize pain and distress, and training for aseptic surgeries. Consult with your research team to determine if you need to complete any of the additional elective courses.
